Traffic Issues

A number of concerns have been communicated to us in relation to traffic at drop off and collection times. Please be vigilant, respect the campus rules and indeed other drivers when dropping off and collecting.

Please;

- Do not let the children out of the car without pulling into the drop off area. This stops the traffic moving and is dangerous.
- Do not remain in the drop off waiting, this can prevent another car from dropping off children.
- Stop when turning in to ensure that children or bikes are not going to step out at both gates.
- Do not let children out on the road side of the car which is extremely dangerous.
- Do not block the bay areas at collection time restricting afterschool buses from parking.
- Do not block car park spaces in the staff car park.
