### **Standardised Testing**

Standardised testing will take place throughout May. We ask you to ensure your child is present on the day as there will not be another opportunity for your child to sit the test. Standardised Testing only takes place in 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Classes.

Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> May: Drumcondra Reading Test (English) Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> May: Sigma T (Maths)

Thursday 19th May: Sigma T (Part 2) 4th – 6th Class only.

Results will be communicated to you on your child's end of year school report which will be issued in June as per Department of Education Guidelines. As always, it is important to remember that standardised test results only give a snapshot of your child's ability in a particular curricular area and on a specific day. Schools have been issued strict guidelines for completing these tests from the Department of Education. It is important that your child does not feel anxious about these assessments and we would urge you not to focus on them too much at home.
