World Down Syndrome Day (WDSD) is celebrated annually on the 21st of March and is a global awareness day that has been officially observed by the United Nations since 2012.

The date for WDSD is set on the 21st day of the 3rd month as a representation of the extra copy of the triplication (trisomy) of the 21st chromosome that people with Down syndrome are born with. The theme for this year is something we in Swords ETNS continuously promote, "What does inclusion mean"

To celebrate this day we are inviting the staff and children to be creative and *wear socks to show you care* on Monday 21st March. Children are invited to be as creative with their socks as possible and to wear their favourite, funniest, odd or pairs of socks.
