3. The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is	Tuesday 25th January 2022
4. The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	Two weeks from Date of letter of Offer

Note: applications made after the 9th January 2022 will be processed as late applications, the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.

Failure of an applicant to accept an offer within two weeks of date of Letter of Offer may result in the offer being withdrawn.

1. The school will commence accepting applications for admission to other year groups on	1st May 2022
2. The school shall cease accepting applications for admission to other year groups on	30th May 2022
3. The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is	On or before 30th June 2022
4. The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	Up to 1 week

Note: applications made after the 30th May 2022 will be processed as late applications, the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.

Failure of an applicant to accept an offer within one week of date of Letter of Offer may result in the offer being withdrawn.
